P.A. 97-0609

On August 26, 2011 Governor Pat Quinn signed Senate Bill 1831 (Public Act 97-0609) this Act amended the Illinois Open Meetings Act and the Illinois Pension Code.

The Act provides that within six days of approving its budget, an Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF) employer must post information for each employee having a total compensation package that exceeds \$75,000/- per year.

Additionally, any IMRF employer who approves an employee total compensation package equal to or exceeding \$150,000 per year must post that information at least six days prior to the approval of the budget.

Total compensation, according to the Act, is defined as salary, health insurance, a housing allowance, a vehicle allowance, bonuses, loans, vacation days and sick days granted.

In accordance with the definition of total compensation with in the Act, the Village of Sauk Village has no employee subject to the separate disclosure of compensation equal to or greater than \$150,000.

Under P.A. 97-0609 the Village of Sauk Village is only required to disclose compensation of employee who participates in IMRF. However, the Village is providing the attached list of employees with an estimate of the true compensation which includes other costs of the Village that benefit the employee. We have sought to include all positions, including those covered by all retirement programs except part-time and or on-call employees. This information is as of May 1, 2015 for the Fiscal Year 2015-2016.
