VILLAGE OF SAUK VILLAGE ORDINANCE NO. 25-007

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR ALL CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE VILLAGE OF SAUK VILLAGE, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2025 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2026

WHEREAS, the Village of Sauk Village, State of Illinois ("Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Village is a municipality operating under the annual appropriations system pursuant to Section 8-2-9 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-2-9); and

WHEREAS, Section 8-2-9 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-2-9) requires a municipality with less than five hundred thousand (500,000) inhabitants to adopt and pass an ordinance appropriating such sums of money as are deemed necessary to defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of the municipality and which specifies the objects and purposes for which these appropriations are made and the amount appropriated for each object or purpose; and WHEREAS, the annual appropriations for the May 1, 2025 to April 30, 2026 fiscal year (FY 2025-2026) (or a formally prepared appropriation document upon which this Ordinance is based) has been and currently is conveniently available for public inspection in the Village of Sauk Village Municipal Center, the office of the Village Treasurer, the office of the Village Clerk, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sauk Village (the "Corporate Authorities") have held all hearings and caused all notices and publications to be posted and published in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sauk Village, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing preambles are restated and incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth herein. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statues. All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this Ordinance are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. There is hereby budgeted and appropriated for corporate purposes of the Village for FY 2025-26 the sum of Fourteen Million, One Hundred and Twenty Thousand, One Hundred and Eight Dollars (\$14,120,108.00), to be provided for by the general taxes levied and from other sources of revenues and reserves, operational transfers and advances. The various objects and purposes for which said budget and appropriations are herein made are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. Notices of availability for public inspection of the annual budget and this appropriation ordinance and the public hearing have been given at least ten (10) days prior to the time of the hearing by publication in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality, see **Exhibit B** attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
