Dear Sauk Village Residents,

Over the past two years, our community has experienced challenges with the water billing system, including inaccurate meter readings, incorrect billing dates, and inconsistent account balances. After a careful and comprehensive review, we have identified the primary causes of these issues and are now taking action to correct them.

To ensure accuracy moving forward, the Village will request authorization from the Board of Trustees to engage our meter-reading vendor to reset and re-code all residential accounts. This work will require the vendor to be on-site in Sauk Village for an undetermined number of days to collaborate with our Public Works Department. As part of this process, residents may be contacted to schedule a meter inspection or replacement. Advance notices will be sent before any home visits occur. During this transition and system correction period, we will temporarily bill all residential households the minimum monthly charge of **\$63.70** until further notice.

Additionally, we are pleased to share that Cook County has expanded its Water Affordability Program. In partnership with the Village administration and the County, eligible residents with past-due balances will be named to determine program assistance for qualifying households.

We appreciate your patience, understanding, and cooperation as we work diligently to restore accuracy, transparency, and confidence in our water billing system.

Our commitment remains to serve you with integrity and ensure long-term improvements for our community.

Looking ahead to 2026, what would you like to see in your community?



Homeowner Relief Fund

The Cook County Homeowner Relief Fund provides \$1,000 in one-time assistance to qualifying homeowners.

Applications are only open for a short time. Funds are limited.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Cook County Homeowner Relief Fund, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- You must own and occupy the property as your **primary residence**.
- Your total **household income** must be at or below 100% of the Cook County Area Median Income (AMI).
- Your **property tax bill must have increased** by at least 50% in any of the 2021, 2022 or 2023 tax years.

SEPTEMBER 29 - OCTOBER 10, 2025

LIHEAP programs offer heating and electric assistance to income eligible households.
Apply TODAY online or call a Partner Intake Site!

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) - Direct Vendor Payment (DVP) - Provides a one-time benefit toward a household's heating and/or electric bills.

Reconnection Assistance (RA) - Provides a benefit of up to \$1500 to prevent imminent disconnection or to re-connect a household's heating and/or electric services.

*LIHEAP-DVP and RA are also available for households heated by oil or propane.

Cash Assistance (CA) - Provides a cash benefit to eligible households whose heating utilities are included in the rent.

Peoples Gas Share the Warmth (STW) - Provides a benefit of up to \$200 towards the past-due balance of your Peoples Gas Bill.

Utility Billing Relief (UBR) - Provides a 50% Rate Reduction on your water, sewer and water-sewer tax bills. No Shut off, Penalties or Debt Collection on City of Chicago utility billing debt. Debt Forgiveness after successfully completing one full year in the program.

Income Guidelines

Program eligibility is based on your household's size and 30-day income. Contact a representative at one of our Partner Intake Sites to discuss your household's current or future eligibility.




