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**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-0002**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 74-136 "STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OUTSIDE BUSINESS OR RESIDENCE DISTRICT" OF ARTICLE V. "PARKING" OF CHAPTER 74 "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES" OF THE SAUK VILLAGE MUNICIPAL CODE TO REGULATE PARKING DURING GARBAGE PICKUP**

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**WHEREAS**, the Village of Sauk Village, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Corporate Authorities") may amend the text of the municipal code from time to time to meet the changing needs of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined it to be in the best interests of the Village to amend Section 74-136 of the Municipal Code to regulate temporary food dealers in the Village of Sauk Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sauk Village, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** Section 74-136: Stopping, Standing or Parking Outside Business or Residence District of Article V: Parking of Chapter 74: Traffic and Vehicles of the Sauk Village Municipal Code is hereby amended by eliminating the stricken language and adding the underlined language as follows:

Sec. 74-136. - Stopping, standing or parking outside business or residence district.

- (a) Outside of a business or residence district, no person shall stop, park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, upon the roadway when it is practicable to stop, park or so leave the vehicle off the roadway, but in every event an unobstructed width of the highway opposite a standing vehicle shall be left for the free passage of other vehicles, and a clear view of the stopped vehicle shall be available from a distance of 200 feet in each direction upon the highway.
- (b) The village, with respect to highways under its jurisdiction or for the maintenance of which it is responsible, may place signs prohibiting or restricting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on any highway where, in its opinion, stopping, standing or parking is dangerous to those using the highway, or where stopping, standing or parking vehicles would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic thereon. Any regulations adopted by the village regarding the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles upon any specific street, streets or highways become effective at the time of the erection of appropriate signs indicating the regulations.
- (c) This section, section 74-135 and 625 ILCS 5/11-1304 shall not apply to the driver of any vehicle which is disabled in such manner and to such extent that it is impossible to avoid stopping and temporarily leaving the vehicle in such position.
- (d) No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, upon the side of a roadway on a block which is within an area zoned with a residential district zoning classification between the hours of ~~7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.~~ 6:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., on the days when the corresponding side of the block is scheduled for garbage pickup.

**Section 3.** If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** Any Ordinance or portion of any Ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed solely to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


